## **Spark New Zealand Limited: Annual Meeting Results**

At Spark New Zealand's Annual Meeting in Auckland today, shareholders were asked to vote on four resolutions, all of which were supported by the Board. All resolutions were decided by poll.

The resolutions passed by shareholders today were:

- 1. That the directors are authorised to fix the auditor's remuneration.
- 2. That Mr Mark Verbiest is re-elected as a director of Spark New Zealand.
- 3. That Dr Murray Horn is re-elected as a director of Spark New Zealand.
- 4. That Mr Ido Leffler is elected as a director of Spark New Zealand.
